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In order to be considered for a scholarship, students must complete the following and return, along with the first page, to the Fire & Police Administration Offices by March 30, 2018.

- (1) HIGH SCHOOL AND/OR COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT. Another H.S. Transcript will not be necessary if student has previously applied for our scholarship.
- (2) Letter of Acceptance into a College or University.
- (3) Letter no more than 2 pages describing why student would like to receive a scholarship. Be sure to provide career and life goals.

Please make every effort to return the packet with all of the requested information ASAP. Make sure that all of the required items are returned in a sealed envelope with your name on the front. Two applications turned in last year on the last day had missing info and were disqualified. Don't let this happen to you.

Applications will be pick up every Friday until the deadline on March 30. We will personally let you know if your info is in good order and if not, give you time to email the missing info to us before the deadline.
